

# History Subject Index

An alphabetical index of topics and place-names for mediaeval and modern history.

Most references are to the **Modern History** collection: e.g. "B-9" means "Modern History B-9".

References to other subject-classes are given in bold (e.g. **Economics N-6**)

The **Modern History** collection is arranged largely by place, and then by period. There is little provision for specific topics, so subject indexing is difficult.

If you cannot find the topic you want in this index:

(1) try a KEYWORD search in the on-line catalogue;

(2) ask at the ARTS FACULTY TEAM OFFICE (Brotherton.Library, Main Building, Floor 3).
